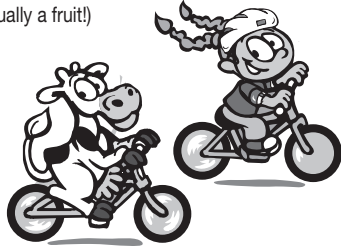


Fruits Across The Country!

Lift-Off! has traveled all across the U.S.A. to discover the "Official Fruits" of many of our states! Check out the map below to see what states have official fruits and what they are!

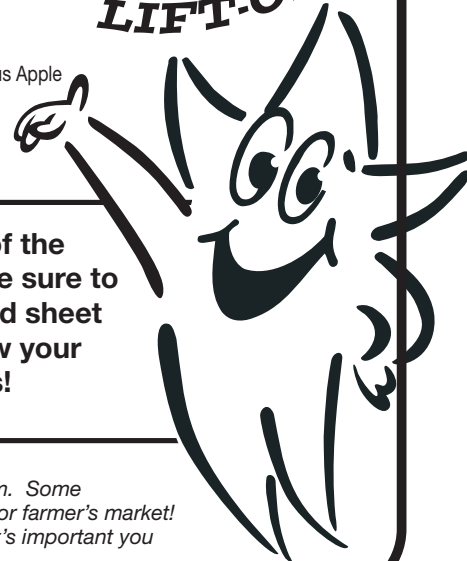


- Alabama: Blackberry and Peach

**This state's fruit is called the wild blueberry, but never pick berries or any other fruits in the wild and eat them. Some poisonous fruits look a lot like safe fruits! Always get your fruits (and vegetables) from a grocery store, farm, or farmer's market!
 **Check with a parent or guardian before trying grapefruit. This fruit can interact with certain medicines, so it's important you know whether or not you can eat grapefruit!*
